

Requirements

PARENTS: HELPFUL HINT

Before signing your child up for Driver Education-please visit www.mybmv.com to find out state requirements for driver education. Click on the Driver Education tab to see all related information.

When you sign up for a Driver Education class, we will issue a CDE form on the 1st day of class for the student to obtain their permit. When the student passes the written/visual exams at the BMV they will receive their permit. They will not be able to obtain a learner's permit at 15 years of age without being registered in class.

Students must be 15 years old to sign up for driver education.

As of July 1, 2012 you are required to take the state written examination to obtain a learner permit. This examination will **not** have to be taken again to obtain a license.

Documents required by the BMV to obtain Permit:

Examples:

Identity/Lawful status-Birth Certificate/Passport with stamp or seal

Indiana Residency (must have 2 forms that state Name and Address)-Bank Statement, Pay Stub, Hospital Bill, W-2

Social Security Card-Original Document (visit www.mybmv.com for additional information.)

Learner Permit: Supervised Driving Only

Age to obtain learner permit:

15 years with Driver Education. May **not** begin classroom or behind-the-wheel training before this time. 16 years without Driver Education

Probationary License: Unsupervised Driving/Restrictions

Minimum age to obtain license:

16 years and 90 days with Driver Education

16 years and 270 days without Driver Education

Driving Log applies to all new drivers

You must log 50 hours of supervised practice driving with a licensed instructor or a licensed driver. (10 hours shall be nighttime driving.)

Effective July 1, 2011, a copy of the driving log is available at www.in.gov/bmv and must be submitted to the BMV when applying for a new license.
